Lifetime Judicial Achievement Award

2020 Recipient

Honorable Robert J. Colombo, Jr., Retired Wayne County Circuit Court

Robert J. Colombo, Jr. was elected to the Wayne County Circuit Court serving from 1983 through 2018, the last 5 years as Chief Judge.

He graduated from the University of Miami cum laude with a BBA in accounting and from Detroit College of Law cum laude with a J.D.

Judge Colombo clerked for Michigan Court of Appeals Judge George Bashara, Jr. He practiced civil, criminal and domestic relations in the trial and appellate courts at Riley and Roumell.

For 25 years he was the asbestos judge in Wayne County. The Michigan Supreme Court appointed him the state's breast implant judge. He tried Dow Corning's breast implant coverage case. The Court of Appeals noted " the remarkable skill and patience exhibited by Judge Colombo in the face of some of the most complex and expansive litigation in the history of the state."

Judge Colombo is married to Workers' Compensation Magistrate Jane Sullivan Colombo and they have 2 sons.
